BROUILLY Lieu-dit « LA CHAIZE » Monopole 2022

Eager youthfulness and depth fill this wine. Purple in color, the wine opens with a layered nose of black raspberry, alpine strawberry, black plum, rosehip, dried cranberry and violet blossom. The palate welcomes you with freshness and doubles down on black fruit that lingers on the delicious finish.
